The company grew dynamically and built more and more production and administration buildings. Today, the largely preserved building and factory complex extends in the square between Berliner Straße, Klingestraße and Ziegelstraße as well as the former harbor area. After 1914, the company history of Mantz and Gerstenberger was eventful. The largest number of employees, 900, was reached at the beginning of the 1920s through the production of gramophone housings. In 1953, the Gerstenberger family moved to the West.. The company was nationalized and produced standard furniture. In 1993, the property was transferred back to the Gerstenberger family. Today, in addition to the "Theater des Lachens" in the old boiler house, the

The Documentation Center is a place of information, discussion and learning, a kind of history lesson on site. The young people who visit the documentation center should get a picture of life in the GDR. They can form their own opinions, uninfluenced by adults, parents and school.</p>
Konzerthalle Carl Philipp Emanuel Bach	Flexible	Lebuser Mauerstraße 4 15230 Frankfurt (Oder)	<p>Great choral symphonies by the Singakademie, captivating concerts by the Brandenburg State Orchestra Frankfurt, performances by international soloists and ensembles and much more about music can be found in the traditional "Carl Philipp Emanuel Bach" concert hall on the banks of the Oder.</p> <p>The former Franciscan church combines a musical and architectural experience under its gracefully painted Gothic vaulted ceiling. The centerpiece of what is probably the most beautiful concert hall in East Brandenburg is the magnificent Sauer organ with 50 stops, built in 1975.</p> <p>Built in the 13th and 16th centuries, the Franciscan monastery church was rededicated as a concert hall in 1967 after extensive reconstruction. It became associated with the work of Carl Philipp Emanuel Bach when it was given its name in 1971.</p>

This resource must be responsibly preserved, expanded and researched, exhibited and communicated at a high level.</p> <p>In July 2017, the organisation emerged from the merger of the Museum Junge Kunst Frankfurt (Oder) and the Kunstmuseum Dieselkraftwerk Cottbus. In Frankfurt (Oder), regularly changing exhibitions can be seen in the two exhibition spaces in the Rathaushalle and the Packhof. In addition to the</p>

Memorial and Documentation Site "Victims of Political Tyranny"	Only Tuesday 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. Thursday 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.	Collegienstraße 10 15230 Frankfurt (Oder)	The memorial and documentation site "Victims of Political Tyranny" provides information on the history of political persecution during National Socialism, under Soviet occupation and in the GDR era at an authentic location. Selected biographies are used to draw attention to people from the city and the region who were persecuted because of their political convictions, their faith, their race, their oppositional behavior or merely on suspicion, who were sent to the camps, caught up in the mills of political criminal justice, lost their lives under inhumane conditions or were even deliberately murdered. One area of the building with five cells was not reconstructed, but left in its original state as an authentic site. The fates of well-known Frankfurt citizens from 1933 to 1989 are presented in the cells. In addition, a single cell from around 1960 and a detention cell from 1989 provide information about the conditions of detention.
